- A court-issued document intended to protect an individual from harm or harassment by another person.

Types of Protective Orders:

- Emergency Protective Orders (EPOs)
- Temporary Protective Orders (TPOs)
- Permanent or Long-Term Protective Orders

When to Seek One:

- Evidence of domestic violence, harassment, stalking, or credible threats of harm.

Preliminary Considerations

- **Assess your immediate safety and that of any children involved.**
- **Emergency Situations**
 - What Constitutes an Emergency? If your spouse or significant other physically assaults you:
 - First, call 911 and law enforcement.
 - Second, call your lawyer to discuss obtaining a protective order.
 - Many other situations may be urgent and important to your case but do not rise to the level of an emergency. Our staff will ensure that information is conveyed to an attorney, and you will receive a response as soon as possible, usually within the same business day.
 - Whether your issue is emergent, urgent, important, or in the normal course of business, we are committed to addressing your concerns and responding promptly.
- **Collect documentation or evidence, including:**
 - Police reports
 - Medical records
 - Photographs of injuries or damages
 - Witness statements
 - Emails, texts, or social media messages

Filing for a Protective Order

Step 1: Determine Jurisdiction

- File in the jurisdiction where the abuse occurred or where you reside.

Step 2: Prepare Necessary Documents

- Protective order petition or application
- Supporting affidavits detailing incidents of abuse or threats
- Identification and proof of relationship to the respondent

Step 3: Submit Filing

- File documents with the appropriate family or district court.

Step 4: Attend the Initial Hearing

- Be prepared to provide testimony and present evidence.

Temporary Protective Order

- Issued pending a full hearing for a permanent order.
- **Common provisions include:**
 - No-contact orders
 - Stay-away orders
 - Custody and visitation restrictions
 - Temporary financial support

Hearing for Permanent Protective Order

- **Prepare for the hearing:**
 - Gather and organize all evidence.
 - Identify witnesses and ensure their availability.
 - Work closely with your attorney.
- **At the hearing:**

 - Respond to cross-examination professionally.
 - Stay focused on facts relevant to the protective order.

Post-Order Considerations

- **Compliance and Enforcement**

Checklist for Protective Order Process

After the Order is Granted:

- Notify local law enforcement, schools, and workplaces of the order.
- Keep a certified copy of the order on hand at all times.
- Monitor the respondent's compliance and report violations.

If the Order is Violated:

- Contact law enforcement immediately to report the violation.
- Document the incident and retain any evidence of the breach.
- Inform your attorney and file a motion for enforcement or contempt if needed.
